REUNION REGISTRATION OPENS MARCH 28th

REGISTER BY APRIL 28th AND YOUR REUNION MIGHT BE FREE!

Five years ago we graduated and left the campus we called home behind, having made memories and friends that we knew would last a lifetime. From **Thursday, June 9 to Sunday, June 12, 2011** we hope you can come back to campus to revisit those times, reconnect with classmates, visit your favorite hangouts, and leave the stress of everyday life behind as you return home for your Alumni Orientation!

The waiting is finally over! You can register for Reunion online at classof06.alumni.cornell.edu starting on Monday, March 28th. As an added bonus, if you **register by April 28th**, you are eligible to **win one of five free Reunions**—that's right, the Class of 2006 will be covering the Reunion Costs for five lucky individuals who register before April 28th!

HOW MUCH WILL REUNION COST?



There are two main components that go into the cost of your Reunion weekend: the class fee and the cost of housing for the weekend. The Class of 2006 is offering two packages for the class fee: The "Full Weekend" (Thursday – Sunday) for \$148.00 and the "Late Arrival" (Friday after 9pm – Sunday) for \$133.00. **Please note that after May 1st the prices increase to \$173.00 for the Full Weekend and \$158.00 for the Late Arrival.** The class fee includes major meals, including (but not limited to) a champagne breakfast, dinner catered by Dinosaur Barb-B-Que on Saturday as well as beer, wine, soda, and snacks at class headquarters throughout the weekend, and your class souvenirs.

Our class has housing available in Dickson, which is available for \$54.00 per night or \$128.00 for all three nights, and includes towels and linens.

We've done our best to keep costs down and make Reunion as affordable as possible, but we realize it may still be beyond financial reach of some of our classmates. The Class of 2006 has set aside a small fund to assist our classmates who can't come to Reunion solely because of financial hardship. If the only thing keeping you from returning to campus is the cost, please email Classof2006@cornell.edu for more information. All inquiries will be kept confidential.

PACKAGE FAQs

What does the class registration fee include?

All packages include class receptions and meals, souvenirs, class shuttles, tent admission, headquarters snacks and beverages, entertainment, and most university events. The University Youth Program, some athletic events, and a few ticketed university events are NOT included.

What if I register and then can't come?

We are happy to offer refunds if you cancel before May 27.

Can I register when I get there?

Yes, you can—but please consider that it's much easier on your reunion chairs if you sign up beforehand so they order enough food and beverages for the weekend.

What's the class wine tour?

The wine tour is an optional activity on Friday. There is an additional charge of \$45 per adult, which includes bus transportation, a box lunch from Collegetown Bagels, and tastings at various Cayuga Lake wineries. The bus will leave from Risley Hall at approximately 10:30 a.m. and return at approximately 4:00 p.m. Final details will be available online as soon as they are confirmed. Space is limited, so sign up early!

HOUSING FAQS

What's included in the room fee?

The university provides bath towels, bed linens, hangers, broadband Internet, and there is a daily towel exchange. You'll want to bring your own radio, alarm clock, hair dryer, iron, and mobile phone, as the only landline phones are in the hallways. A limited number of porta-cribs are available on a first-in-Ithaca basis. We recommend you bring your own if needed. Please remember that the residence halls do not have air conditioning. Bring a fan in case of warm weather.

When is check in/check out?

Thursday at noon/Sunday by noon.

Can I smoke in the dorms or bring my pet?

No and no (unless your pet is a service animal).

Can I get a room near my friends?

We can try! Room assignments are made on a first-in-Ithaca basis, so get here early and ask to room with or near someone when you check-in.

I have special needs—is it practical for me to stay in the dorms?

Yes! On the paper and online registration forms, there is a space to communicate your needs. Special requests must be received by May 27.

Does our class have a block of rooms at a hotel?

Although we strongly encourage everyone to stay with the Class in Dickson, we do have some hotel rooms reserved. Call the Econolodge (607-257-1400) or the Meadow Court (800-852-4014) well before May 4 (when the block will be released) and tell them you're with the Cornell Class of '06. If you end up on the hotel waiting list, you should register for a dorm room in the interim and cancel by May 27 to get a refund.
