"FUN FACTS" THE SAVE MART CENTER

- The 450,000 square-foot center is roughly the size of 236 single-family homes.
- The northwest and southeast lobbies could encompass a seven-story building.
- The clear height in the arena bowl is over 75 feet high, which is tall enough to contain a six-story building.
- The event floor is approximately 33 feet, nearly three stories, below grade.
- At the event floor level, there will be 250 columns supporting the floors and seating above.
- There will be 4.26 million pounds of structural steel used.
- It will take over 1,100 gallons of paint for the interior of the center.
