Peter Robertson has been named manager of membership and marketing in the Alumni Relations Office.

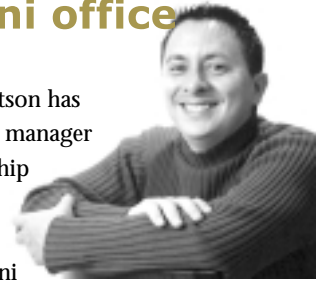
