All background information on the candidates must be compiled by the individual submitting the nomination. The nominator must provide all materials pertinent to the nomination. The Awards and Recognition Committee will not do further research on behalf of any nominee. Nominations and supporting materials will be held for three years so that candidates can be given consideration over a longer period of time.
